

COURSE TITLE: REGULATING THE SECURITIES MARKET: REGULATORY FRAMEWORK AND OVERVIEW OF THE ECSM SECURITIES LEGISLATION

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This session discusses the body of legislation governing the ECSM [Securities Act and Amendment, Regulations, Rules] and the objectives of regulation, identifying the regulators (Commission and SROs) and providing information as to their structure and operations.

The course requires a first degree in Finance or similar certification or supervisory/management experience in a regulated financial institution.
