COURSE TITLE: REGULATING THE SECURITIES MARKET - UNDERSTANDING COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT SCHEMES

This session discusses the definition of a Collective Investment Scheme and the requirements of the Securities Act and Regulation as regards to the establishment of such schemes within the ECSM.
